## All Leagues

- Coach Requirements
  - **Complete NAYS Insurance Website**
  - Practice Location – up to the coach, DGIL Fields are available for \$20 up until the season starts, after start of the regular season, DGIL Fields are closed for team practices.
  - It is recommended to try to introduce any/all coaches to parents as they are dropping off and/or picking up their kids from practice – this helps parents become more comfortable with who is working with their kids.
  - Uniforms – Up to the coach, Any style, names, numbers, logos, pants/shorts, hats/visors, belts, etc. are open, you can have as much or as little of this as you want. DGIL is sponsored by several screen printing businesses – please contact a Board Member if you would like more information regarding these businesses. **\*\*\*Uniforms cannot contain any adult related themes (Tavern's, Gambling, Etc.) or inappropriate names\*\*\***
    - It is recommended that head and assistant coaches wear uniforms with their names on them especially in E & D League – this will lead to better communication from parents that may still be getting familiar with who the coaches are.
- Entry Fee
  - \$1 at the gate for regular season games, \$2 for Tournaments
  - Punch Cards are available (22) punches for \$20 – These are not accepted for outside run non DGIL Tournament Games
- General
  - Players from previous year's team have first rights to return to the team.
  - After 3/24 deadline, players are placed on teams in order of sign up.
  - New players or players wishing to switch teams will be placed on a waiting list and will be placed on a team with the most demand (indicate team preference in notes section during registration). Roster size max will be 12 players. If all teams are maxed out, players may be added by the board.
  - If you are interested in creating a new team, please contact us via website.
  - Grade is considered current grade on date of sign up.
  - League starts 3rd week in May and ends 3rd week in July. A league may start later due to High School.

\*\* If Purchasing a bat - It must bear either the ASA approved 2000 certification mark , the ASA 2004 certification mark, or the ASA 2013 Certification Mark (Slow Pitch ONLY) and must not be listed on an ASA Non-Approved Bat List with Certification Marks, must be included on a list of approved bat models published by the ASA National Office; or must, in the sole opinion and discretion of the umpire, have been manufactured prior to 2000 and if tested, would comply with the ASA bat performance standards then in effect. This includes Wooden Bats.
